Communicated climate risks for decision-makers at 13+ public and private forums and provided 4 written and oral submissions to Stormont Committees.

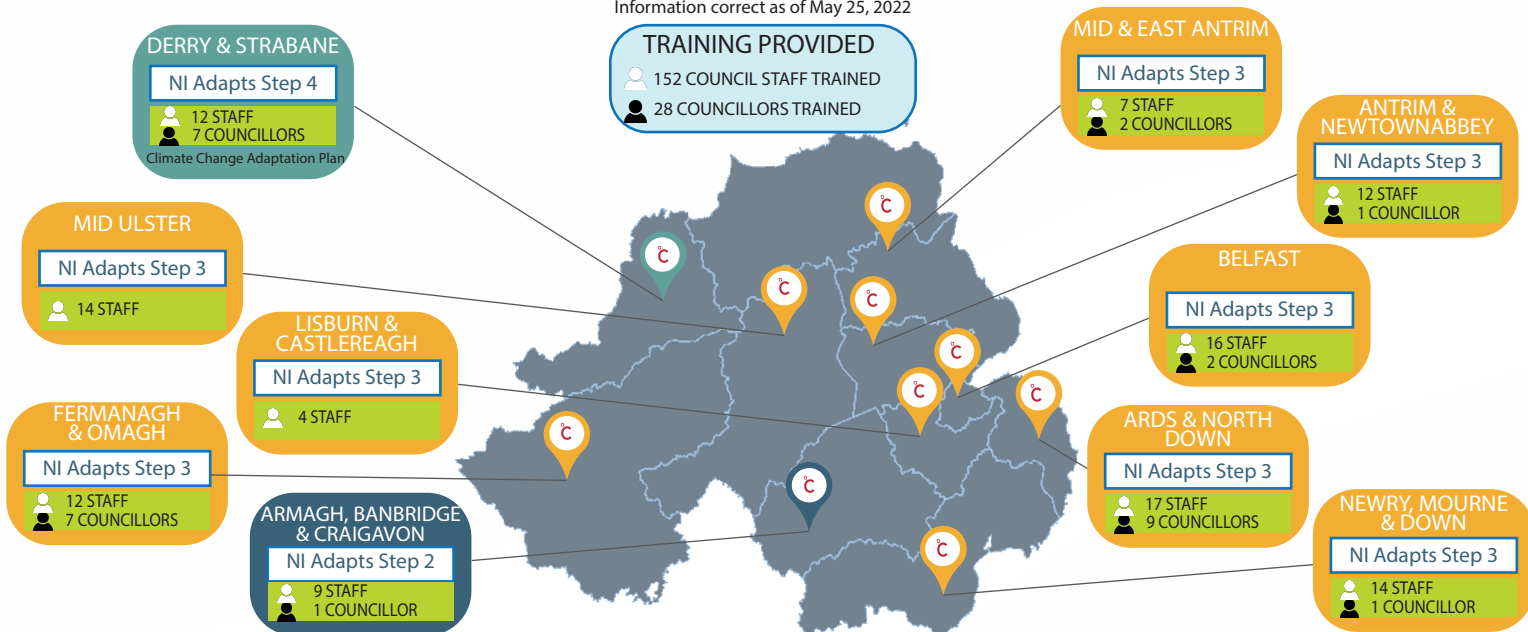
### 2021- 2022 Highlight

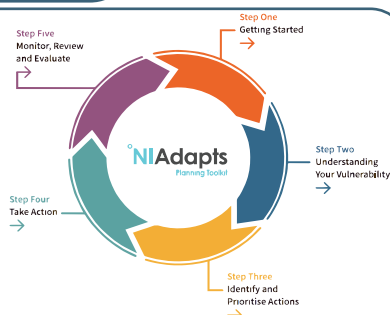
